

**WINDSOR PORT AUTHORITY
NOTICE
(pursuant to Section 51 of The Canada Marine Act)**

The Windsor Port Authority hereby gives notice of its proposal to revise (increase) the existing fees for wharfage, berthage and storage set out in its Wharf By-Law and the existing harbour fees and cargo rates set out in its Harbour Fees and Cargo Rates By-Law, effective May 1, 2017, and to make certain housekeeping changes in each of the said By-Laws, as follows:

1. The Wharf By-Law (By-Law No. 2) will be amended by increasing, by three (3%) per cent, the amount of wharfage fees applicable to each item set out in Column 3 of Schedule A, the amount of berthage fees applicable to each item set out in Column 2 of each of Schedules B, C and D and the amount of storage fees applicable to each item set out in Column 2 of Schedule E thereto.
2. The Harbour Fees and Cargo Rates By-Law (By-Law No. 1) will be amended by increasing, by three (3%), per cent the amount of harbour fees applicable to each item set out in Column 2 of Schedule A of the By-Law and the amount of cargo rates applicable to each item set out in Column 3 of Schedule B of the By-Law.
3. Since application of a percentage increase in fees may result in overprecision in calculating the fees increase, in making the calculations decimal values have been rounded to four decimal places (being one hundredth of a cent).
4. As a housekeeping matter, the word “that” contained in paragraph 9 of the English version of By Law-No. 1 (the Harbour Fees and Cargo Rates By-Law), as amended, and the word “that” contained in paragraph 11 of the English version of By-Law No. 2 (the Wharfage By-Law), as amended, shall be deleted and replaced with the word “when”. In addition, housekeeping changes are to be made to the French language versions of the two By-Laws. Those housekeeping changes are essentially enhancements to terminology and corrections to certain spelling and grammatical errors made in process of French translation.
