Under the Windsor Port Authority's Bylaws 1 and 2, certain fees, rates and charges are payable. As required under section 32 (4) and (5) of the Port Authority Operations Regulations, the owner or the person in charge of a Ship shall provide the Port Authority with the description, quantity and tonnage of the cargo loaded, unloaded, or transferred at each berth or anchorage, within 24 hours of the loading, unloading, or transfer. The information shall be given by a certificate signed by the owner or person in charge of the Ship, and the certificate shall be hand delivered or transmitted by facsimile or electronic mail.
